



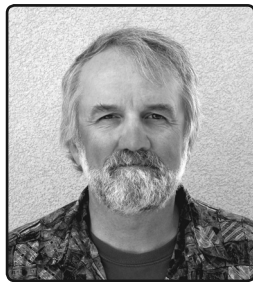

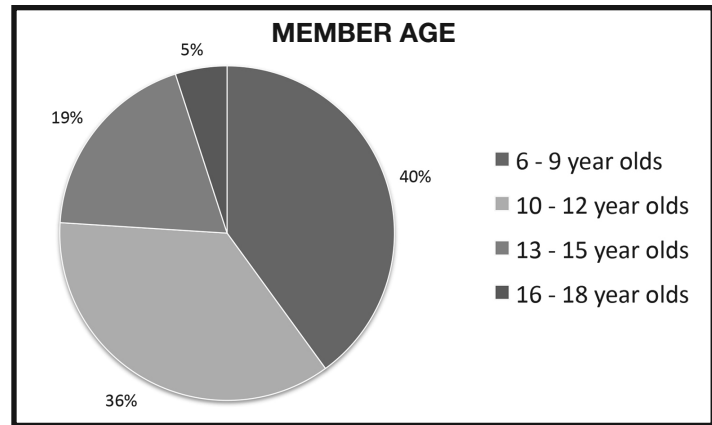
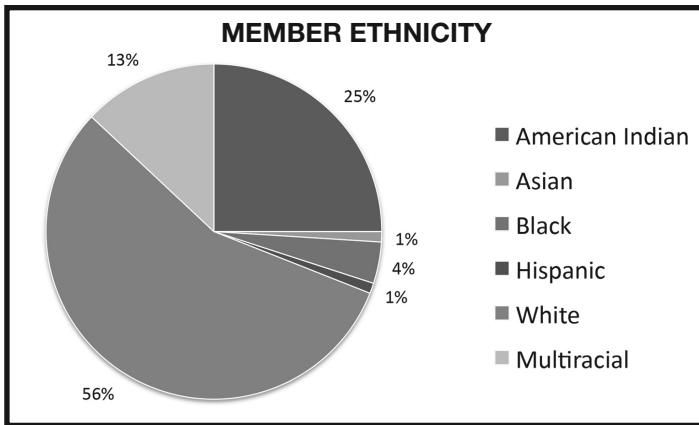

Annual household income profiles for members

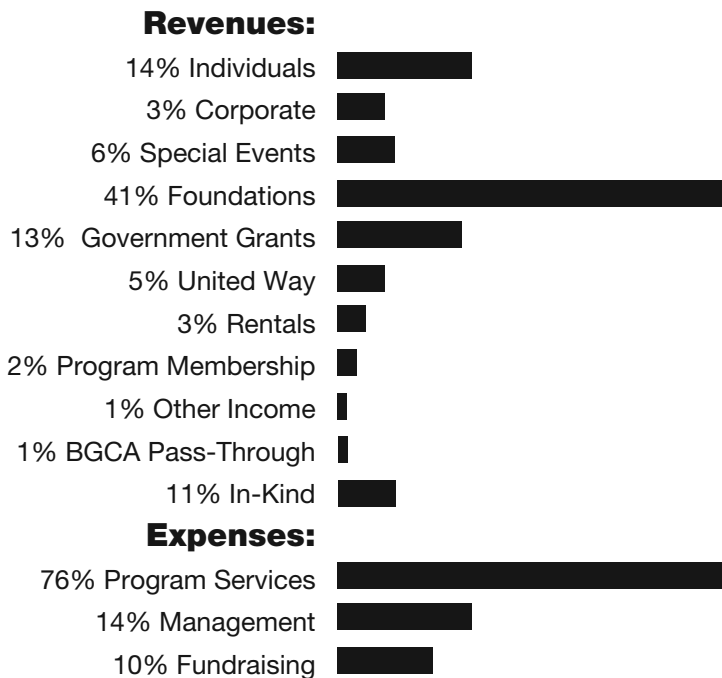
- o 48 percent from single parent households
