Eligibility:

Youth must be 6 years old and completed kindergarten.

Youth in grades 1-12, based on grade youth are going into fall 2025.

Function in a 1:10 ratio.

Live in the designated neighborhood.

Membership cost:

Fees this program for youth in grades 1-12 are covered by a grant through Minnesota Department of Public Safety for summer 2025.

Closures:

The Club reserves the right to change its hours and days of operation. If changes occur, families will be notified.

GOOD TO KNOW

Registration Process:

Interested families may complete a membership application paper form.

Club staff will reach out to families as spots open up in our outreach summer program.

All families should be prepared to complete the following to sign their child up:

- fill out the application form
- proof of residence within the neighborhood applying for
- · complete and sign permission & waivers

Extra Items:

We encourage families to please refrain from sending any toys or personal items as they will not be allowed during Club programming. Backpacks and personal items will remain is a designated location, all Club youth are offered a secure spot for their belongings.

Food Program:

Food served for lunch and snack will be prepared by Club kitchen staff in a commercial kitchen and transported to the designated neighborhood. If your child has any allergies or dietary restrictions, please let the staff know and we will work to accommodate your child's needs.

Policies & Procedures:

Pick-up Procedure

Families are required to sign their child out of Club programming, families may allow their child to walk/bike home at a designated time that must be listed on their application form. If families choose this option, they agree that after the child signs themselves out that they are releasing the Boys & Girls Club from all liability at that time.

All youth must be signed out with the time.

Late Pickups

- The Club On-The-Go program ends promptly at 5:00 PM for enrolled youth.
- If your child has not been picked up by 5:00 PM, we will call the numbers of authorized individuals who you have listed on your account.
- If we are unable to reach an authorized individual by 15 minutes after their designated closing time then Club staff will call law enforcement to provide a safe ride home for your child(ren).
